Talk to two different people at separate locations at the same time. Three-Way Calling makes it easy to plan activities or just plain chat. Works with both local and long-distance calls.

How to use Three-Way Calling

- Get the first person on the line, then press the FLASH key or switchhook ("hang up") button to put that call on hold.
- At the normal dial tone, call the second person.
- After that person answers, press FLASH again to connect all three of you.
- To hang up the second call, press FLASH again. The original call ends when the first person hangs up.

If the second person doesn't answer:

• Simply press FLASH twice to cancel and keep talking to the first person.
