## Your First Bill

Your first bill is often higher than the bills you can expect in months ahead because one-time installation charges usually apply. And, you are charged for some services, such as local telephone service and Internet Service one month in advance. If you begin service in the middle of a month, you will be filled for that partial month in which service was installed and for the month you are charged in advance.

## How it Works

Example: Services ordered in the middle of the month
Services ordered-first month's bill with prorated charges for partial month and advance charges for next month:
Local Service $\$ 10.00$
High Speed Internet \$30.00
Prorated Local Service \$ 5.00
Prorated High Speed Internet \$15.00
Total Charges $\$ 60.00$
Services ordered-standard month to month bill:
Local Service $\$ 10.00$
High Speed Internet \$30.00
Total $\$ 40.00$

## How it Appears on your Bill (Residential)

For residential customers with a Bundle/Package your bill will look similar to the example below. Amounts will vary depending on your services and installation date.
