How it works	<p>Purchased on a circuit basis, PRIs provide 23 voice channels per circuit, with each channel supporting a single phone call. A PRI connects directly to your onsite PBX, and as more lines are needed, new circuits can be purchased in increments of 23, or they can be leased on a channel-by-channel basis.</p>  <p>The diagram shows a central PBX connected to staff and computers.
