[On August 11, 2011, the FCC issued a waiver of the obligation to file the ONA Users Guide, and the Quarterly Installation and Maintenance reports with the FCC. (WC 10-132, CC 95-20, 98-10)]

**Note 2:** CNSs must be included in ONA Users Guide. CNSs do not need to be federally tariffed or included in CEI Plans.
