Summary:

Copper retirements are necessary to respond to various factors in the Outside Plant, including road construction, maintenance problems, and growth accommodation. Specific information will be provided with each disclosure.

Due to road construction, state or local municipal agencies in the areas noted below have mandated that CenturyLink move its copper facilities. As a result, CenturyLink will be retiring all copper facilities in these areas as detailed below. No copper facilities will be available in these areas after the First Implementation Date. Due to these circumstances, which are outside CenturyLink's control, CenturyLink cannot comply with the notice periods set forth in Commission Rule 51.333(b)(2). Pursuant to Rule 51.333(g)(2), CenturyLink is providing notice of this network change as soon as practicable and is entitled to a reduced waiting period commensurate with these circumstances.

According to CenturyLink's records, there are no working circuits, including competitive carrier circuits, on these copper facilities. The reduced waiting period therefore should have no negative impact on any telephone exchange service provider.

In this revised notice, CenturyLink makes certain changes to this notice after consulting with FCC staff.
