We are providing you with service over our new state of the art Fiber Optic technology. This means you can send and receive information over longer distances much faster.

There are two devices that have been placed on your property to provide you with this new service. An Optical Network Terminal (ONT) has been placed on the outside or inside of your home, and a battery backup unit has been placed inside your home. The battery back-up unit is very important because during an electrical power outage, it powers your ONT which enables your communication services. The battery back-up plugs into an existing standard outlet.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

You are responsible for replacing the battery within the battery back-up unit enclosure. A typical battery will last

about 3 years; however, it is important to periodically check it just like you do the batteries in your smoke detectors. Each battery back-up unit enclosure has a battery indicator light on the front. If the indicator light next to the picture of a battery with an 'X' through it is **on**, the battery needs to be replaced.

If your battery fails within 3 years of the initial installation of the battery back-up unit (check date on the battery once it is removed), it is covered under warranty. If that happens, contact the supplier of the battery backup unit:
